

## **STAY TOYOOKA INITIATIVE**

~Providing Toyooka Residents with Local Accommodation Subsidies~

The state of emergency pertaining to the Act on Special Measures concerning the new strains of infection has been lifted, but, for the time being, Toyooka City still does not expect many visitors from outside of Toyooka to come to our city. At present, Toyooka residents also have anxieties about the prospects of welcoming visitors from outside of town.

Because of this, we will be encouraging Toyooka residents to stay at local accommodation venues through an initiative we are titling “STAY TOYOOKA”.

The field of hospitality is a wide one. When a hospitality organization is in place, you can expect a ripple effect onto various other industries such as rice, meat, fishing, vegetable farming, liquor, towels, taxi services, and more.

### **The Purpose of the Initiative**

---

#### **1 Supporting accommodation venues by promoting regional consumption**

We will be providing urgent support to accommodation owners who are at the center of the tourism industry — the pillar of industry in Toyooka City.

We are encouraging citizens to support Toyooka accommodation venues in order to encourage local consumption.

This will be incorporated into a seamless policy measure together with the “Go To” campaign, which is planned to be implemented by the national government in the future.

#### **2 Reducing stress and anxiety of both citizens and those involved in the hospitality industry**

In order to tackle Toyooka residents’ anxieties about actively welcoming people from outside of the area, to start, our residents themselves will help out in alleviating anxieties. By targeting citizens, we can reduce anxieties of hospitality employees and maintain a sense of motivation through providing actual customers to businesses.

### **Initiative Explanation**

---

#### **1 Subsidy Eligibility**

Residents of Toyooka staying at an accommodation with family members or relatives.

\*\* You may also stay by yourself.

(In July, friends/acquaintances will also be allowed to stay at an accommodation together).

## 2 Assistance Percentage

The subsidy will cover half of the accommodation charge, rounded down to the nearest 100 yen. The maximum price that a subsidy will cover is 10,000 yen for 1 person/ 1 night.

**Note:** An accommodation plan price will generally encompass both lodging and course meals. However, this excludes additional food and drink fees, service fees, and tax.

## 3 Duration Period

The subsidy will cover accommodation reservations between June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2020 (Mon.) to July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020 (Fri.).

However, if the initiative reaches its maximum allotted budget, it will finish early.

## 4 Participating Venues

Venues which submitted an implementation notification form to the city in order to participate in STAY TOYOOKA have all met the following conditions:

- Owners are in possession of a business license issued by Hotel and Ryokan Management Law
- Facilities taking active infection prevention measures and have adopted the “Guideline for COVID-19 for Accommodation Facilities (ver. 1)” created by the National Ryokan and Hotel Sanitation Association

## Number of Times One Can Use the Accommodation Subsidy

---

There is no limit.

### How to Use STAY TOYOOKA

- ① Look at the list of venues and pick where you'd like to stay.
- ② When making a reservation, clearly state **"I would like to use STAY TOYOOKA"**.
- ③ Download the application (2 pg.), fill it out, and **stamp** it.
- ④ Bring your application with you to the venue.
- ⑤ Turn your application in to the front desk.
- ⑥ Stay the night and have fun.
- ⑦ The subsidy will cover **HALF** the price (up to ¥10,000/person).

## Terms of Use

---

### 1. Make a Reservation

Contact your desired accommodation venue directly via **phone, etc.**

When making a reservation, let the person in charge know that you would like to use the STAY TOYOOKA subsidy.

**Note:** Depending on the venue, you may need to contact the Toyooka travel agency or a booking website. For further details, please read the list of participating venues below:

**Note:** In the case that you are reserving from the website of a local venue, you must submit a subsidy application form to Toyooka City Hall. Please keep in mind that the procedures listed below may differ. If you do not apply in advance, the stay will not be covered by a subsidy.

### 2. Fill out the following documents (i.e. Subsidy Application Form.)

**In order to be granted the STAY TOYOOKA subsidy, you must go through the necessary application procedures.**

The necessary documents are as follows:

- (1) Subsidy Grant Application Form and Declaration (Doc 2)

**Note: Must be stamped with a personal seal.**

- (2) Subsidy Project Result Report/ Combined Invoice/ Letter of Proxy (Doc 4)

**Note: Must be stamped with a personal seal.**

#### OPTION 1 «How to receive the application before checking in»

- Download from the City Hall homepage (2 page)
- Receive it from the Tourism Division on the 2nd floor of Toyooka City Hall, or your local branch of Toyooka City Hall in Kinosaki, Izushi, Hidaka, or Tanto.





#### OPTION 2 «How to apply when checking in»

**Note: Please bring a personal seal with you.**

- When checking into your chosen accommodation, turn your subsidy application form in directly to the people in charge.

3. (On the night of the stay) bring the subsidy application form (2 pages) with you to the accommodation venue along with a form of ID.

«Examples of Personal Identification»

· Driver's License    · Health Insurance Card    · Residence Card    etc.

4. Turn in your subsidy application and display your personal ID upon checking in.

5. When paying for the accommodation, pay the discounted amount within the subsidy limit.

The subsidy will cover **half** of the accommodation charge, rounded down to the nearest 100 yen. The **max price** that a subsidy will cover is 10,000 yen for 1 person/ 1 night.  
*e.g. If you have a room which is 15,000 yen per person, you will pay 7,500 yen per person (i.e. half).  
 However, if you have a room which is 25,000 yen per person, you will pay 15,000 yen per person (because the max price that the subsidy covers is 10,000 yen).*

**Note:** An accommodation plan price will generally encompass both lodging and course meals. However, this excludes additional food and drink fees, service fees, and tax.

\*Course meals include breakfast and dinner.
